Thank you for your letter requesting approval to use green-colored pavement in marked bicycle lanes and bicycle lane extensions statewide in Arizona, including all local jurisdictions. Your request was made under the provisions of Section 1A.10 in the 2009 edition of the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways* (MUTCD) and our Interim Approval memorandum (IA-14) dated April 15, 2011 for the optional use of green-colored pavement for bicycle lanes.

Your request is approved. Please maintain and periodically update a list of all locations where green-colored pavement is installed in Arizona.
